During the 2017/2018 school year, Freedom provided resources to nearly 7,000 students who completed their Patriot Program requirements.

James and Youth's Benefit.

Students are recognized for their participation and achievement during a patriot assembly held at each school. Parents and the local community, including military personnel, are invited to congratulate the students who complete this level of achievement. Assemblies include patriotic poems, recitals and even role playing of famous historic figures like Abraham Lincoln and George Washington. Students memorize the state capitals, Gettysburg Address, Paul Revere's Ride and they also learn fun patriotic songs.

The Patriot program was developed by the schools' PTAs, school administrators, teachers, and parent volunteers.
