

Opening Your First Credit Card

Opening your first credit card is considered one of the rites of passage into adulthood... but with so much conflicting information, it can be confusing to know how to get started.

Choosing a Credit Card

You'll need to build your credit history from the ground up, starting with cards that offer a low limit but will accept almost any applicants.

Look for these features when making your choice:

- •No annual fees. You shouldn't have to pay money to use your card, and don't be concerned with 'perks'. Concentrate on building your credit score.
- •A low interest rate. For your first card, you likely won't be offered a low rate, but that doesn't mean you should be taken for a ride. Shop around for a card offering a reasonable rate.
- •Incentives for good behavior. Look for a card that offers incentives, such as a bonus each month when the bill is paid on time or a waived first late-payment fee.
