## **BE ON GUARD FOR AI FRAUD**

Artificial intelligence (AI) is revolutionizing the way we live and work. Unfortunately, though, it's also revolutionizing the way scammers play their games. Here's what you need to know about AI fraud and how to protect yourself.

WHAT IS AI FRAUD? AI fraud is the use of artificial intelligence to deceive or defraud individuals or organizations. When using AI to pull off a scam, fraudsters use algorithms to create convincing fake identities, manipulate social media, generate realistic fake images and videos (AKA "deepfakes") and more. The scammers then create fake social media profiles and email addresses using bogus identities and footage. They may create fake websites or emails that appear to be from legitimate sources, such as financial institutions or government agencies, and ask people to provide their personal information or login credentials.

#### Al fraud comes in several forms, including:

- Phishing
- Fake news
- ID theft
- Social engineering
- Deepfakes
- Chatbot scams

#### Look out for these red flags:

- Multiple unsolicited emails and/or text messages
- Asked to provide personal info or login credentials by an unverified contact
- Unusual activity on your social media accounts

If you notice any of these signs, it's important to investigate. If the contact claims to represent a government agency or financial institution, do not engage. Reach out to the agency that supposedly contacted you to see if the communication is legit.

#### Ways to protect yourself:

- Never share sensitive info with an unverified contact.
- Use strong, unique passwords across all of your accounts.
- Keep your device's security on its strongest setting.
- Use updated antivirus software.

If you suspect you've been the victim of Al fraud, act quickly to mitigate damage. First, contact Freedom FCU at to let us know your information has been compromised. Similarly, reach out to your credit card companies to let them know about the fraud. Next, report the fraud to the FTC so they can take appropriate measures in catching the humans behind the bot-generated scam. You'll also want to change your passwords and consider a credit freeze. Finally, if your identity has been stolen, reach out to **identitytheft.gov** to learn your next steps.

## **VACATION BUDGETING 101**

It's great to get away from the daily grind, but budgets never go on vacation. Here's what you need to know about planning your funds for your next trip.

**SET YOUR BUDGET** First, determine how much you can actually spend while on your trip. Research the location you want to visit and the cost to get there, the price you'll pay for accommodations and transportation. Look up the cost of local attractions. Make a basic list of anticipated expenses and work with that number to set a vacation budget.

PLAN YOUR EXPENSES Once you have your budget and a basic list of expenses, work on setting an exact dollar amount for each vacation category. If the total amount is outside your affordable range, consider swapping out some expenses for cheaper, or even free, alternatives. TRACK YOUR EXPENSES Next, you'll need to track your expenses to ensure you stick to your spending plan. A budgeting app, like Mint or YNAB, can make this easier. If you find yourself overspending in any category, look for lastminute ways to cut back.

#### TIPS FOR STICKING TO YOUR BUDGET

- Use cash. Keeping the plastic hidden while on vacation will force you to stick to your plan.
- Book in advance. Hotel stays, car rentals, tours and more are nearly always cheaper when reserved ahead. You'll also leave fewer spending choices for your actual vacation when your willpower may be weaker.
- Keep a copy of your budget with you on vacation. Pull out your copy whenever you come up against a money challenge on vacation to remind you of your spending plan.
